Answer: J96.00 (Acute respiratory failure, unspecified severity) should be sequenced first if the respiratory failure is the reason for admission. The coding guidelines state that U07.1 may be secondary to an acute respiratory failure code.

Question 3 (CPT Surgery): The surgeon performs a total knee arthroplasty. During the same operative session, the surgeon also performs an open reduction of a patellar fracture. How are the codes reported?

Answer: The total knee arthroplasty code (27447) includes the open reduction of the patella in many cases—check the CPT manual. Typically, 27447 includes repair of patellar fracture. But if separate, use modifier 59 or 22. This question tests understanding of inclusive procedures.
