Using Your Cox Remote Control

The most direct method is through your Cox cable box. Simply press the **Guide** button on your remote control. This will bring up the on-screen interactive menu. You can scroll through listings by

Cox has invested heavily in its Contour platform. If you have a Contour box or use the Cox Contour app on your smartphone or tablet, you have a powerful channel guide at your fingertips. The app provides the same **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** listings as your TV, but with added features like voice search and personalized recommendations. You can even set your DVR recordings from the app, making it easy to never miss KEYT’s evening broadcast while you are out enjoying the Santa Barbara waterfront.

Online Channel Lineup Tool

For a quick reference, Cox maintains an online channel lineup tool. By visiting the Cox website and entering your Santa Barbara ZIP code, you can view a complete, downloadable list of channels available in your specific package. This is incredibly useful for planning your viewing or comparing packages. The online tool often provides additional details about each channel, including HD availability and channel number.

The Printed Guide Option

While less common today, Cox occasionally offers a printed version of the **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** upon request. This is a great option for those who prefer a physical reference or for less tech-savvy family members. However, the digital versions are far more updated and comprehensive, as channel lineups can change when new networks are added or removed.

UNDERSTANDING THE COX SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL LINEUP BY PACKAGE

Your specific **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** depends entirely on the TV package you subscribe to. Cox offers several tiers, each with a different selection of channels. Understanding these tiers helps you know exactly what you are paying for and where to find your favorite content.

Cox Starter TV (Limited Basic)

This is the most basic package, often required if you have internet service. It provides essential local channels and a few public access stations. In Santa Barbara, this typically includes:

- Local broadcast channels (KEYT 3, KCOY 12, KTLA 5, KQED 9)
- C-SPAN
- Local government access channels (City of Santa Barbara meetings, County meetings)
- A few over-the-air digital networks

If you only need local news and network primetime, this may suffice. The channel numbers for these local stations are generally consistent: 3 for KEYT, 12 for KCOY, and 9 for PBS.

Cox Essential TV (Expanded Basic)

This is the most popular residential package in Santa Barbara. It includes everything in Starter TV plus a robust selection of popular cable networks. You will find channels like:

- **News:** CNN, Fox News, MSNBC, CNBC, HLN
- **Entertainment:** TBS, TNT, USA Network, FX, AMC, Comedy Central
- **Sports:** ESPN, ESPN2, FS1, NFL Network
- **Kids:** Nickelodeon, Cartoon Network, Disney Channel
- **Lifestyle:** HGTV, Food Network, TLC, Bravo

Within the **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara**, these channels are usually found in the 20 to 80 range, though exact numbers can vary. Check your guide for precise placement.

Cox Preferred TV (Premium Tier)

Stepping up to Preferred TV adds more niche and premium channels. This package is for viewers who want more variety. You gain access to networks such as:

- Discovery Channel
- National Geographic
- BET
- MTV
- Hallmark Channel
- Additional sports packages
- More movie channels

If you find yourself scrolling past the same 50 channels and wanting more, Preferred TV is likely the right tier for you.

Cox Preferred Plus and Contour TV

The top-tier packages from Cox include everything from the lower tiers plus hundreds of additional networks. This is where you find extensive specialty channels, international programming, and a massive library of on-demand content. In Santa Barbara, this package often includes regional sports networks that cover local college teams and professional sports from Los Angeles and the Bay Area. The **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** for Contour TV users is fully integrated with the voice remote, allowing you to say a show or actor’s name and jump directly to the content.

Premium Channels (Add-Ons)

Regardless of your base package, you can add premium channels to your subscription. These include:

- HBO
- Showtime
- Cinemax
- Starz
- MGM+

These premium channels are typically found in the 300 to 500 range on the **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara**, though HD versions often occupy different slots. Adding these unlocks blockbuster movies, original series, and exclusive documentaries.

FINDING LOCAL CHANNELS IN SANTA BARBARA

One of the most common questions from Cox subscribers in Santa Barbara is about locating local broadcast channels. Because Santa Barbara sits in a unique media market, your network affiliations may differ slightly from other areas. Here is a quick reference for key local stations you will find in your guide:

- **KEYT (ABC):** Channel 3
- **KCOY (CBS):** Channel 12
- **KTLA (CW):** Channel 5
- **KQED (PBS):** Channel 9
- **KTTV (FOX):** Channel 11
- **KNBC (NBC):** Channel 4

These channels provide the backbone of your local news coverage, syndicated daytime shows, and primetime network programming. Your **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** will list these prominently, often in the single-digit or low-double-digit channel slots.

HD VS. SD: UNDERSTANDING CHANNEL NUMBERS

Many Cox subscribers are confused by duplicate channel numbers. In the **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara**, you will often see two versions of the same network: one in standard definition (SD) and one in high definition (HD). HD channels are usually, but not always, assigned higher numbers. For example, ESPN might be on channel 31 in SD and channel 1031 in HD. Always check your guide for the HD designation to ensure you are getting the best picture quality for your 4K or HD television. Cox's guide clearly marks HD channels with an "HD" icon next to the channel name.

USING THE COX CHANNEL GUIDE FOR SPORTS IN SANTA BARBARA

Sports fans in Santa Barbara have unique needs. You may want to watch the Dodgers, Lakers, Rams, or local university teams from UC Santa Barbara. The **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** includes several regional sports networks (RSNs) depending on your package. Look for channels like:

- Bally Sports SoCal (for Dodgers, Angels, Lakers, Clippers, Kings)
- Bally Sports West (for additional regional coverage)
- ESPN and ESPN2 (for national broadcasts)
- Fox Sports 1 and 2
- NFL Network and NFL RedZone
- MLB Network
- NBA TV
- Golf Channel

If you are a heavy sports viewer, ensure your package includes the RSNs, as these are often part of higher-tier packages. Use the **Sports** category filter in your guide to see all sports programming airing at any given time.

ON-DEMAND CONTENT AND THE CHANNEL GUIDE

The **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** is not just for live TV. It also integrates Cox On Demand, a massive library of movies, TV shows, and exclusive content. When you browse the guide, you will see On Demand listings alongside live programming. You can browse by genre such as Kids, Movies, Music, or News. Popular On Demand categories in the Santa Barbara area include:

- Recent movie releases
- Full seasons of current TV shows
- Cox originals
- Free programming for basic subscribers

To access On Demand, press the **On Demand** button on your remote or select the On Demand tab in the guide menu. This is a fantastic way to watch what you want, when you want, without needing a separate streaming subscription.

SETTING UP YOUR DVR WITH THE CHANNEL GUIDE

If you have a Cox DVR or Contour DVR, the **Cox Channel Guide Santa Barbara** is your control center for recordings. You can:

- Browse the guide for upcoming shows
- Select a show and choose **Record** or **Series Record**
- Manage conflicts when two shows air at the same time
- View your recording history
- Set recordings remotely using the Contour app

For example, if you want to record every episode of a new series on TNT, simply find it in the guide, select the future airing, and choose **Record Series**. The DVR will automatically capture every new episode, even if the time slot changes.
