Character Guide: Building the Ultimate Party

SONIC THE HEDGEHOG

MILES "TAILS" PROWER

KNUCKLES THE ECHIDNA

Role: Tank / Physical Damage. Knuckles has the highest HP and Defense in the game. He is your front-line brawler. His moves often involve breaking enemy defenses or dealing massive single-target damage. Make sure to level his Attack and HP first.

AMY ROSE

Role: Support / Debuffer. Amy uses her Piko Piko Hammer to stun enemies and provide buffs to the party. She is also your primary item user thanks to her high Luck stat, which increases the chance of finding rare items after battle. She is a great choice for grinding levels.

SHADOW THE HEDGEHOG

Role: Glass Cannon. Shadow deals incredible damage, especially with his Chaos Spear and Chaos Blast abilities. However, he has lower HP than Sonic. Use him to eliminate high-priority threats quickly. Pair him with a healer like Tails.

ROUGE THE BAT

Role: Thief / Disabler. Rouge is unique because she can steal items from enemies. Her "Distract" move can also put enemies to sleep or confuse them. She is invaluable for farming rare items and controlling the flow of battle.

ERAZOR DJINN (SPOILER CHARACTER)

Role: Magic User. Erazor is a late-game character with powerful

dark magic. He can hit all enemies at once and has a unique "Curse" ability that lowers enemy stats. He is an excellent replacement for Shadow if you prefer a more magical approach.

Exploration and Puzzles: Navigating the Zones

The world of Sonic Chronicles is divided into several hub areas and dungeons. While the game is linear, exploration is rewarded. Always talk to every NPC (Non-Playable Character) you find. Many side quests are hidden in plain sight, offering rare items and experience points.
